WITH the restaurant and catering industry facing a shortage of skilled workers, a local organisation is contributing to a solution.

SCISCO (South Coast Industry, Schools and Community Organisation) Career Pathways has a new Adopt a School venture called Essential Ingredients.

Essential Ingredients coordinator Chelsea Hamre said the program opened up a multitude of partnerships between restaurants and schools.

"Essential Ingredients is a true partnership between a school and a restaurant or venue that develops an understanding and interest in the commercial cookery industry," she said.

"Local restaurants and venues have offered their time and energies to support schools and students in an aim to help close

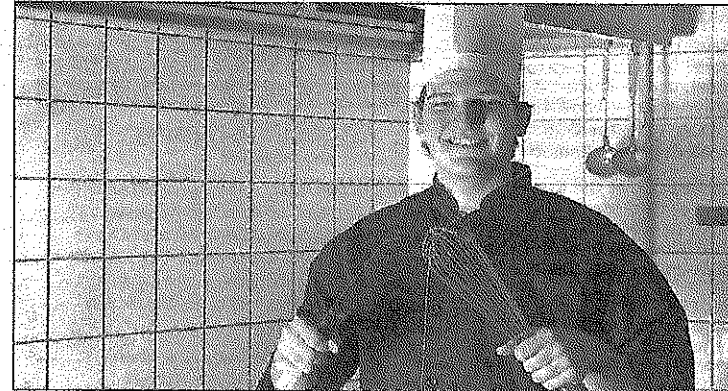
the skill-shortage gaps and provide positive outcomes to those involved."

Managed and facilitated by SCISCO, Merrimac State High School has partnered with Marriott Resort and Spa, Palm Beach Currumbin State High School with Currumbin RSL, Upper Coomera State High School has developed a partnership with WP Clothing, along with Emmanuel College and Town and Country Motel and Restaurant.

"These venues have been supporting and mentoring the Year 10 students of their partner schools," said Ms Hamre.

"They have opened up opportunities for student work experience and on November 17 a cook-off competition will determine a winning school.
