What is the Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) program?

This program gives current secondary students the opportunity to gain workplace experience and provides students with a broad understanding of the world of work to complement their VET in Schools programs. Participation provides young people with a competitive edge in career development through experience in the workplace. SWL develops a range of knowledge, skills and attributes relevant to a wide range of work environments.
