What is the Plan-It Youth Mentoring Program?

Using trained volunteer mentors, this program is available to local high schools and is designed to encourage and assist young people to plan their careers and remained engaged in learning and training.

Mentoring is the development of a one-to-one relationship where sharing and learning can occur between the mentor and the young person.

Who can be involved?

15-16 year old high school students

What do mentors do?

- Listen
- Assist with setting and achieving goals
- Help students recognize their strengths
- Be a sounding board for ideas and problems
- Improve job readiness and job search skills
- Help establish better relationships with adults and peers
- Offer encouragement and guidance that may improve school performance
