Youth Pathways Program

What is Youth Pathways?

Youth Pathways is a voluntary program designed to assist 13-19 year olds, facing multiple barriers, remain at school, explore options and set personal goals through one to one case management. It aims to help young people make a successful transition to complete Year 12 or its equivalent and ultimately to further education, training and active participation in the community.

How can Youth Pathways help?

- Receive individualised support for your particular needs
- Have one-on-one meetings with your Youth Pathways officer
- Assist you to deal with personal issues such as self esteem, bullying, truanting and to reach your goals
- Support to continue your studies and find relevance in your subjects
- Receive advice on school-based vocational options
- Ongoing support and guidance

Who is eligible?

Are you, or do you know someone who is 13-19 years of age, is an Australian citizen or permanent resident who is at risk of leaving school before completing Year 12 **OR** has left school within the last 12 months and not completed Year 12

AND is at risk of not making a successful transition through school, further education, training or employment?
